# The Martyrs of the Faith

---

- **Simon Peter** – Crucified upside down.
- **Andrew** – Crucified on an X shaped cross.
- **James** – Killed by Herod in Acts 12.
- **Philip** – Scourged, imprisoned, then crucified.
- **Bartholomew** – Beaten then crucified in India.
- **Thomas** – Speared to death in India.
- **Matthew** – Killed in Ethiopia.
- **James** – Beaten to death by Jews at age 94.
- **Thaddaeus** – Crucified.
- **Simon the Zealot** – Crucified.
- **Matthias** – Stoned then beheaded.
- **Luke** – Hanged by pagan priests.
- **Paul** – Beheaded by Nero.
- **Mark** – Dragged to pieces.
- **John** – Boiled alive and survived.
