

Vear friends and family,

Greetings from Panama! We have already been back in Panama for six months. Wow, so much has happened! From the Panama church, Comunidad Bíblica de la Gracia (CBG), receiving a short-term mission team from a GMI-affiliated church from Costa Rica to CBG being able to start a teenage youth group, to the Panama field receiving new missionaries! Let's get you caught up!

One of the goals for this year was to plan and launch a youth group specifically for teenagers in our church and community. We praise God that this ministry was launched early this year. This group meets every Saturday from 5 to 6:30 pm and the group's name is "δοῦλος" (Doulos) which is the Greek word for servant. Our goal as a group is to learn more and more to abide in Christ so that we may serve Him. The core group includes four faithful teenagers who have been part of the church since it began almost 4 years ago. The youth group continues to grow, with up to fifteen teens attending the group each week. Since the teenage years are when many beliefs are being shaped in a person, we pray that the teens here in Panama who are part of our church and community can be shaped by the truth of God's Word.

In April, a team from Iglesia Bíblica de la Gracia, a Costa Rican church affiliated with GMI visited Panama to help renovate and paint the church. They also helped with our summer kids' ministry, Equipados, an outdoor ministry in a local park, and evangelism in the streets of David. As Comunidad Bíblica de la Gracia has grown, it has become difficult to fit everyone who participates in our ministries into the building where we meet. By renovating the church we were able to more efficiently







utilize the space we have to better accommodate our members. We were and are very thankful for our brothers and sisters in Christ from Costa Rica and their willingness to leave their country to help the Body of Christ grow here in Panama.

Finally as mentioned in our last prayer letter, we received a new missionary to the field in December, Cecy Torres. She has been a blessing to us and we are thankful for her life and her heart to love and serve the Lord. Additionally, this past June we received two more missionaries, Anthony and Pamela Beaulieu. With this addition, the GMI Panama team has grown to seven missionaries. Our prayer is that God will use the team here in Panama for His glory and that the Body of Christ in Comunidad Bíblica de la Gracia will continue growing and maturing in Christ.

The Panama team's goal is to establish a solid mid-Acts dispensational church in the city of David. We want to share the gospel of Jesus Christ with the lost while also training up Panamanian nationals within our church with sound Biblical doctrine. We are praying that God continues maturing and developing a healthy church with active members who know and rightly divide His Word (II Tim. 2:15).
