WHAT WE BELIEVE: Resurrection

We believe in the physical resurrection of the dead. Jesus Christ was resurrected bodily, and therefore everyone will have a bodily resurrection. The saved will be raised to eternal glory and the unsaved to eternal punishment.



5 Major Views of the Afterlife:

- Reincarnation – come back as a different form
- Enter the Spirit world – tribal religions
- Cease to exist – Atheism
- Don't know

WHAT WE BELIEVE: State of the Dead

We believe that immediately after death all people exist in a state of consciousness that will last forever. The believer of this dispensation passes directly into the presence of Christ in heaven. All of the unsaved dead enter a state of conscious eternal suffering without any hope of salvation.



3 Major Views of Hell:

- Eternal Conscious Torment

Unbelievers will continue to exist in torment forever.

- Conditional Immortality (Annihilationism)

Unbelievers will cease to exist after some amount of judgment.

- Universal Reconciliation

Unbelievers will go to hell, but after some amount of time everyone will eventually go to heaven.
