What is meant by proclaiming the “Kingdom of God”?

Kingdom = King’s Domain

“Where the King is, there’s the Kingdom.”

What is meant by proclaiming the “Kingdom of God”?

- **Universal Kingdom of God** — God’s sovereign rule and reign over everything in the universe (Psalm 103:9)
- **Spiritual Kingdom of God** — The reign of God in a believer’s life enabling them to experience eternal life (Romans 14:17)
- **Millennial Kingdom of Christ** — The promise of God to set up a literal kingdom on earth which will endure for 1000 years (Revelation 20:1-7)
