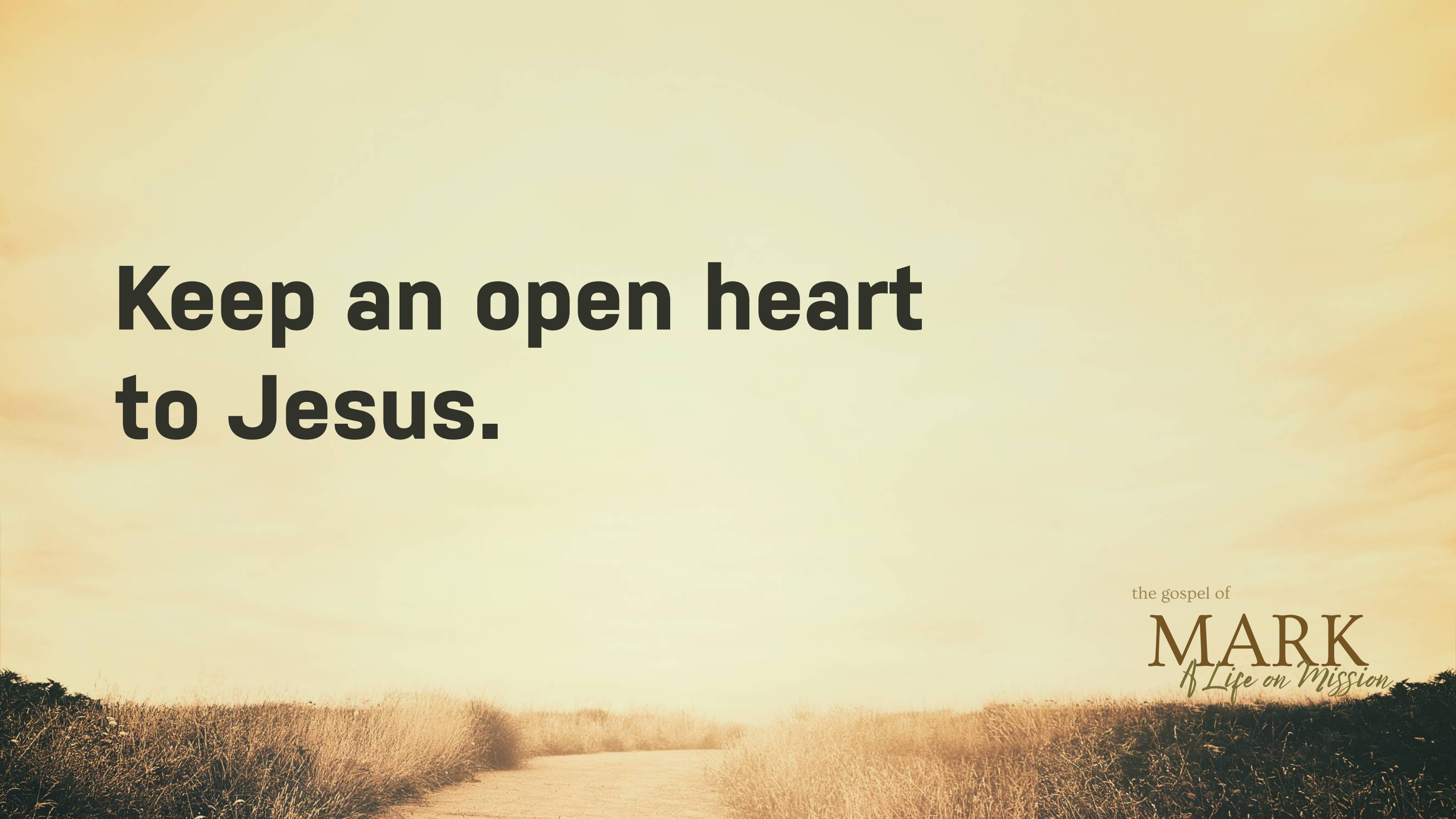


Proverbs 4:20-23

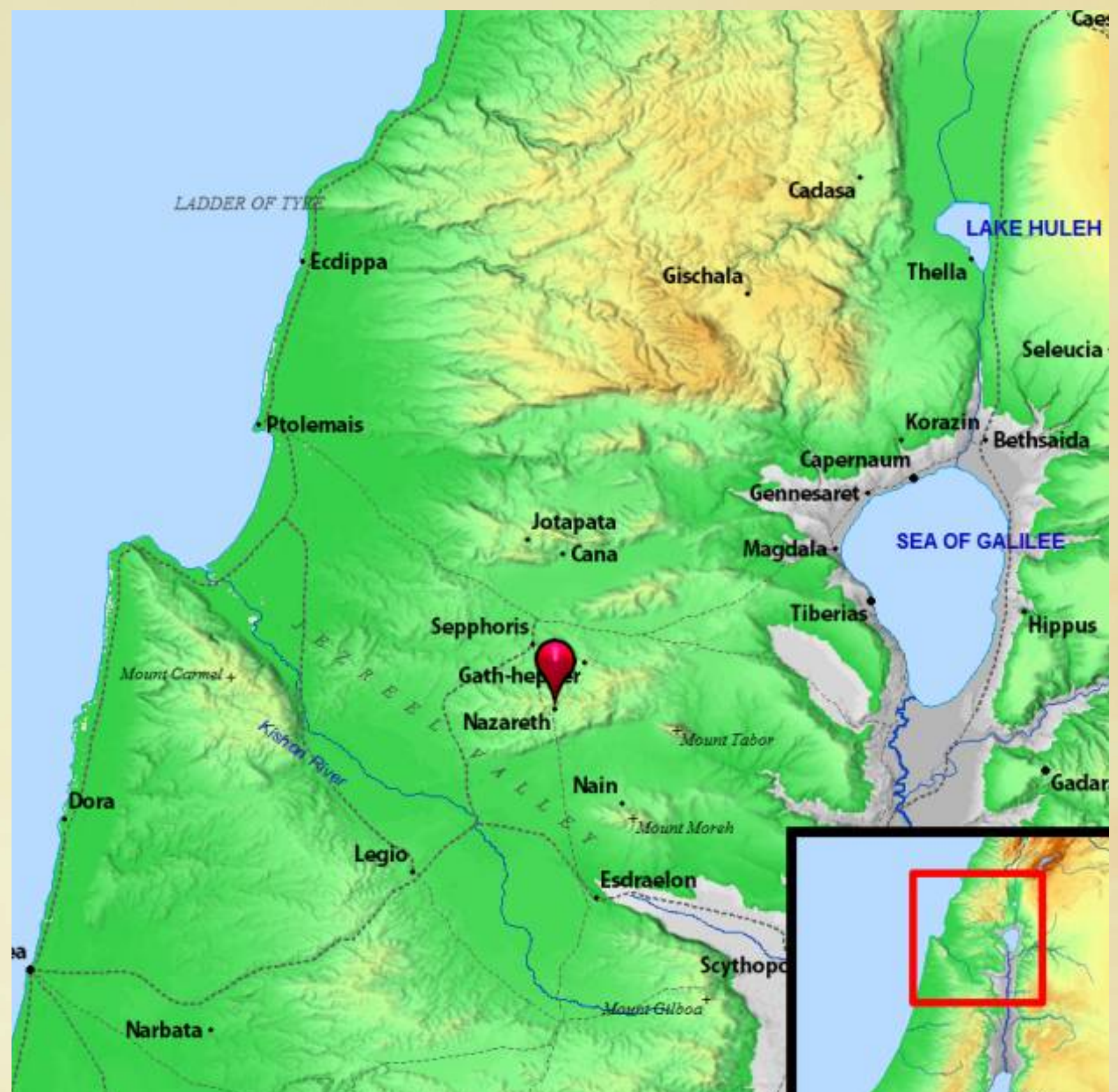
Isaiah 53:1-3 – Despised and Rejected

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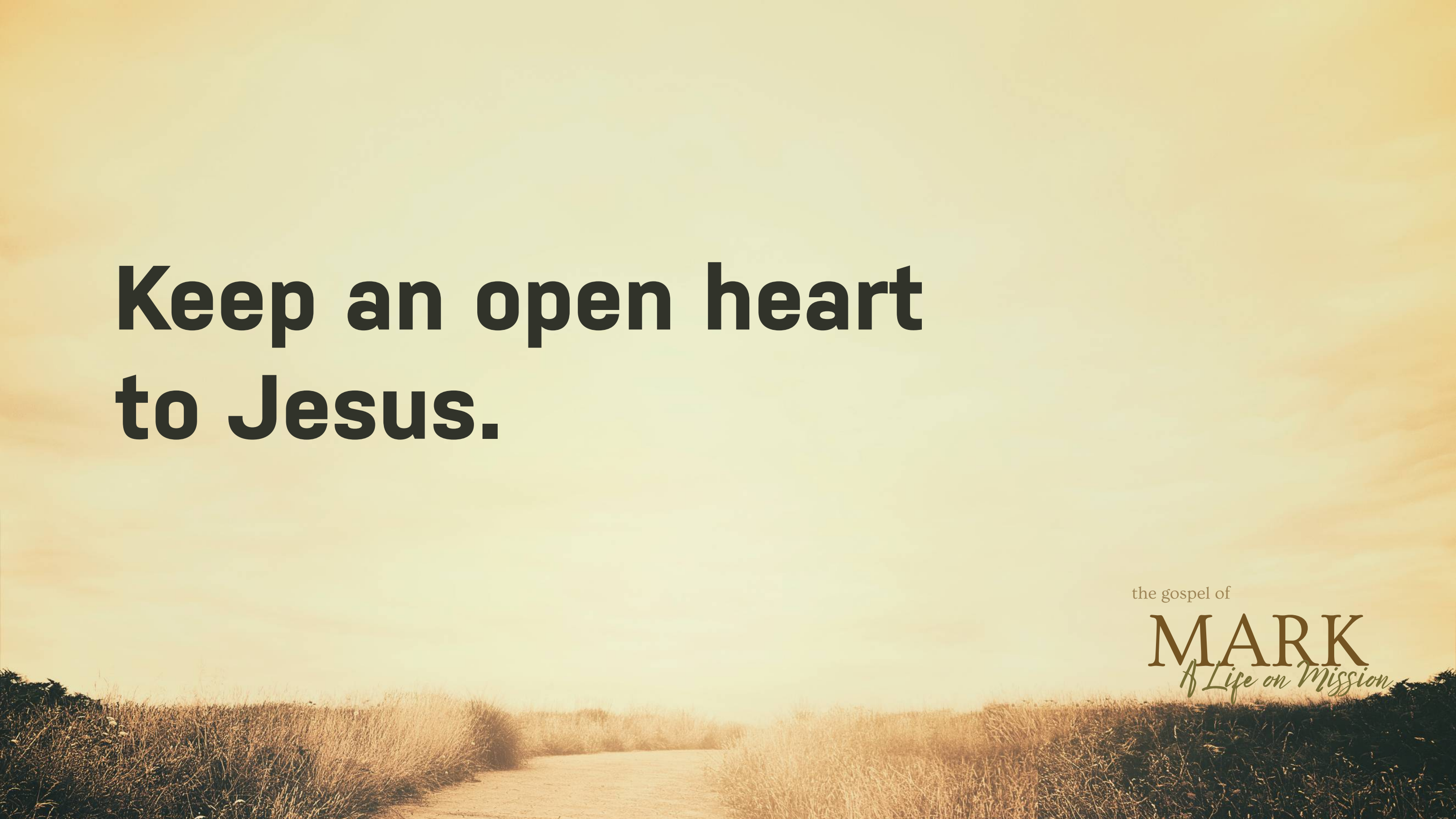
